"Ed Says"

"Vacuum"

Vacuum, it plays a great deal in the operation of any 4 cycle engine. Corvairs need a good vacuum level to operate efficiently and well. The carburetors depend on vacuum to supply the correct amount of fuel. Also, the distributor depends on vacuum to fire the fuel at the correct time. Care should be taken to assure there is no vacuum leaks in any hoses or gaskets. All hoses and gaskets should be checked carefully to prevent any vacuum leaks. These hose are very old and get hard over the years and will not seal. Valve adjustment should also be checked. Barring worn rings, bad valves, and incorrect parts, your Corvair can be tuned up to run like a top!




