## Cavalry in Action!!

The Cavalry made a visit to Art Bringe's to assist him in installing some new o-rings and exhaust gaskets. A couple of the exhaust tubes were bad so we replaced them. New exhaust gaskets are on order so when they arrive we'll get them installed and then we'll have his 180 turbo spinning.

Also Jason came over and we pulled a front fork assembly off an old bike he had. Soon we'll replace it with the bad one that's on the Corvair trike he has. It won't be long and it'll be on the road again!!

Also Bob's 65 quit on him up on the Ugstad Rd. I went up and no gas to the carbs. We figured the gas gauge was not working right. After putting gas in it it ran all the way home. He came over later and I adjusted the valves and checked it out and it ran fine. Later that day it quit again, acting like no gas. On inspection I found the supply line loose on the fuel supply line, and the bolt that holds the Pump down was not in the dimple. After fixing that off he went again. The gas gauge still isn't right but we'll figure it out.

The next project is to rebuild an engine for Bob's Rampside I picked up in Seattle. It's an 145 C.I. early engine converted to late 164 C.I. motor. Then it goes in the loadside. We have to get it back on the road for Bob. I just wish warmer weather would come soon. I was out in the garage a couple days ago pattering and had the heat on.
